Chapter 1

Basic data

Introduction


This report presents a summarized information about the private schools activities and their contribution in satisfying the demand for technical education and vocational training.

Figures and information reported reflect the situation during the school year 1996 - 1997.

1.1 Regional spread

The total number of running schools is 302. Table (1.1) shows their regional distribution.

Table (1.1) calls for the following observations :


- 48% of the schools are situated in Beirut and its suburbs. This concentration reflects the present active population concentration in this region.
- Only 7% of the schools are situated in the vast Bekaa mohafazat where the population density is the lowest.

1.2 Sizes

Private schools are of a rather smaller size than public ones. For more than 58% of their total, the students number does not exceed 100 and only 7.5 % receive more than 300 students. It is worth mentioning that 17% of the schools have less than 20 students.

1.3 Ownership

By law, a private school must be licensed by a governmental decree delivered to a specific person - physical (individual) or moral (association, i.e. NGO).

39% of the total schools are owned by NGOs while 61% are the property of individuals.

1.4 Teaching languages

French, Arabic and English are used as main teaching languages. The schools are free to choose any teaching language.

Table (1.3) depicts the distribution of the private schools as for the mainly used language.

1.5 Courses time

Schools may run day time or evening courses, or both :

- 9% of the schools run only evening courses.
- 80% run only day time courses.
- 11% run both shifts.

1.6 Training types


Private schools are not allowed to deliver diplomas. They may prepare their students to obtain officials certificates (diplomas) delivered by the MTVE - through public exams - or they run some short specific training courses, generally called "private specialities". Students enrolled in those private specialities receive a registration attestation delivered by the school and authenticated by the MTVE.

Private specialization courses range in two categories :

- One semester training, where training extends on a period of about 120 hours.
- Two semester training, with a training of about 500 hours.

1.7 Premises

227 schools provided information about their premises and equipment. Upon this information the following figures showed up : the number of classrooms is estimated to be 5070. 143 schools have laboratories and workshops while 118 schools have libraries.

1.8 Categories of occupations

All courses - either the "private specialities" or those ending in an official certificate - may be classified in nine occupational categories, as follows :

- 1- Office work.
- 2- Industry.
- 3- Services.
- 4- Construction.
- 5- Tourism.
- 6- Health.
- 7- Independent work (+handicrafts).
- 8- Agriculture.
- 9- Languages.



Chapter 2

Students Population

In 1996 - 1997, about 46048 students were enrolled in private schools.

2.1 Distribution according to sex

Males population = 50.4 %

Females population = 49.6 %



When considering this distribution within the "private specialities" only, it ends to the following :

56.6% of the students enrolled in the "one semester courses" are females, and 67 % of those enrolled in the "two semester courses" are females.

As for the distribution within the BT and the TS lines, females represent :

- 47% of the BT population of private schools.
- 45.5% of the TS population of private schools.

2.2 Regional distribution

Table (2.1) shows the geographical distribution of the students over the regions.

A quick calculation shows that 62% of the total Bekaa TVE population and only 42% of the Beirut population are females.









Distribution of public TVE schools students (1996-1997)


1- By sex

Chapter 3

Cost Evaluation

3.1 Teachers distribution over regions

Private schools employ 5265 teachers, most of them working as part time teachers. Males represent 59% of this number.

The distribution of teachers over the regions is described in table (3.1).

3.2 Equivalent number of full time instructors

To evaluate the full time faculty needed in each school, we proceed as follows :

First : Determining the total number of yearly teaching hours per course : HN-course

Second : Summing up the total teaching hours in each school, for each level : H-1 sem ; H-2 sem ; H-CAP ; H-PB ; H-TB ; H-TS. Then summing up all these sums = H-school.

Third : Evaluating the annual teaching hours delivered by a full time teacher, on the assumption that there are 22 effective weeks per year and that a teacher will deliver 24 hours per week. The product is 528.

Fourth : Dividing HN-school by 528. The quotient is the equivalent full time teaching staff by school.

As an alternative to "Third" and "Fourth", we could determine the equivalent teaching staff for each level. This allows a more precise qualitative distribution of the faculty. The results are exposed in table (3.2).

3.4 Other costs

These include :

- The administrative staff salaries.
- Overhead costs : rental value; telephone; water; electricity; local taxes; etc.
- Maintenance cost for the buildings, the playing grounds, the furniture and the equipment.
- Cost of material consumptions for practical works.
- Miscellaneous.

These costs may reasonably be estimated at 30% of the school budget (15% for the administrative staff and 15% for all other expenses) while the teaching costs represent the other 70%.

Hence, the "other costs" value is about 6.6 millions. The total expenses sum up to about \$ 22 millions.

3.5 Tuitons

The amount of the tuitions collected by various schools varies from one school to another.

Table (3.4) lists the mean values of annual tuitions that result from a comparison between several schools.

3.6 Results

The difference between the income of the private technical education sector (\$35 192 500) and its expenses (\$22 000 000) represents US\$ 12 million (30%) per year .

Sponsored Training

Introduction

Some public institutions are NGOs sponsor training programmes which are carried out by private schools according to specific terms of reference.

This chapter presents an overview of the main programmes falling under this definition.

4.1 National office for employment (ONE)

4.1.1 Sponsored schools

The ONE finances the training of a number of persons within selected schools. Table (4.1) summarizes this activity for the school year 1996 - 1997.

4.1.3 Sponsoring conditions

- a- The ONE participates in the payment of tuitions within the limits of L.L. 500 000 per trainee.
- b- The trainee is charged an amount of L.L. 200 000 for complementing the tuition.
- c- The training duration varies from 500 hours to 800 hours.
- d- Trainees of all ages may be admitted.
- e- The curricula are set up by the training schools.

4.2 The Ministry of Social Affairs

4.2.1 Programmes

This Ministry cares for young people who face severe social conditions : orphans; handicapped persons; persons belonging to very poor families; etc. It cooperates with 163 charity institutions through typical agreements for providing accommodation, food, general care, basic education and vocational training to children covered by its assistance.

The training provided by the charity institutions may be of one of three types :

- Accelerated training : this is a non-formal training that could be assimilated to the 1 semester training or 2 semester training offered by private schools. By the end of this training, the student is not awarded any certificate.
- Vocational formal training : it ends in the official BP certificate.
- Technical education : it ends in the technical baccalaureate (BT).

4.2.2 Number of students

In 1997, the Ministry of Social Affairs sponsored the following students numbers in technical and vocational programmes:


